In the period from September 27 to October 1, 2021 we took part in LTT activity in the Turkish town Muğla in a beautiful Antalya region.

The project activities focused on Digitization and culture & the world.

We met students and teachers from partner schools from Turkey, the host country, Czech Republic, Norway, Poland and Portugal.

We learnt about 3D designing and about Carbon footprint, Calculation, Methods for reducing. Participants of all partner schools presented Effects of Digitalisation on culture, common and different points of countries.

All teams joined Practical cycling of electronic devices workshop in ICT atelier to learn about Cycling of electronic devices practically to develop our critical thinking skills. We also had chance to make new simple devices from previously prepared electronic waste materials.

In the afternoons we enjoyed boat trips with a lovely sunset, market places in cities and the whole Turkish nature. We visited mosque and historical and cultural places in Marmaris, Ancient area and Akbük, Kaunos Rock Graves and Ancient City in Dalyan. We completed the Visualisation of archaeological cultural heritage and learnt about Turkish culture. We also tried new meals like baklava and the original Turkish kebab.

We made friends with students from partner schools and we enjoyed every moment spent at school and leisure activities. The dinners with the breathtaking sea views were wonderful and our stay in Turkey was absolutely amazing.
